Grade Level is as of Fall 2018

📖 Kindergarten ~ 5 Picture Books a week (50 books for the summer)	📖 1st Grade ~ 5 Picture Books a week (50 books for the summer)
📖 2nd Grade ~ 7 Picture Books a week (70 books for the summer) or 25 pages (Chapter Book) a week (250 pages for the summer)	📖 3rd Grade ~ 10 Picture Books a week (100 books for the summer) or 30 pages (Chapter Book) a week (300 pages for the summer)
📖 4th Grade ~ 50 pages (Chapter Book) a week (500 pages for the summer)	📖 5th Grade ~ 75 pages (Chapter Book) a week (750 pages for the summer)
📖 6th Grade ~100 pages (Chapter Book) a week (1000 pages for the summer)	

📖 Here’s what you need:

- Student
- Parent, guardian, or adult
- Paper
- Pencil or pen
- Books

📖 Directions:

1. Read your books.
2. Tell someone about what you’ve read
3. Keep a list of the books you have read. (Put the date and the name of the book.)
If you are reading chapter books, each day write down the page numbers you read next to its name.
4. Make sure a parent or guardian signs it.
5. Have fun on your reading adventures!
6. Return signed, completed book log to your new teacher in the fall.
