

After School Enrichment and Safety (ASES) Program

The After School Enrichment and Safety (ASES) Program will open the first day of school and operates every school day through the last day of school. To comply with State and Federal grant requirements the ASES Program will commence immediately upon the conclusion of the regular school day and operates a minimum of 15 hours per week and at least until 6:00 PM on every regular school day. We pride ourselves in creating a safe, engaging, positive setting for our students. To get the most out of their time in the program, students need to attend each day and stay for the entire program.

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday
3:15 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Wednesday
1:45 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Each year the target population differs depending on the school and student needs. This year, the focus groups for the ASES program are: foster youth, homeless, English learners, latchkey status, economical hardship, academic need, and social/emotional need. The program is open to students enrolled in 2nd through 6th grade, **free of charge**.

Parent **MUST** attend an ASES Parent Meeting in order for their child(ren) to be eligible for enrollment into ASES for the 2017-2018 school year.

Any parent who is interested in enrolling their child in the ASES program may fill out an application in the front office. Application submission and/or previous

enrollment does not guarantee placement in the ASES program. Students may not start the program until contacted by the ASES Site Coordinator. However, the ASES program is currently full.
